# Poncichter walking down memory lane:

Tracing the ways of life of German-speakers in Ödenburg/ Sopron at the Hungarian-Austrian border

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## Questions

- 1) How we can map people's memories onto today's Sopron, where bilingual German-Hungarian street signs have been put up in the formerly German-speaking quarters since the 1990s?
- 2) Which factors determine who can claim the label 'Poncichter' nowadays, and are there divergent ways of life of those who belong to the group and those who did/do not?

## **Project Rationale**

This project aims to conceptualise how memories of place function in biographical narratives of speakers of a minority language in a central European border community who speak about their past 'ways of life'.

# **Project Strand 1**

Memories of German-speakers from Sopron are strongly linked to geographical references (streets, monuments, landmarks).

## **Project Strand 2**

Only some German-speakers claim an ethnolinguistic label for Sopron Germanspeakers, Poncichter ('Beangrowers').
